

# GROUP LICENSES: ASSIGNING AND UNASSIGNING PRODUCTS IN BATCHES

A unique **Group Member license** is created for each copy of MATLAB on a Group license. Each Group Member license has its own product configuration. Administrators and asset managers can assign or unassign products to a batch of Group Member licenses at the same time.

**Note:** When assigning products in batches, the License Center does not check for product dependencies, so you should assign all required products as well. After assigning products, install them and get a new License File.

To get started...

1 Select the **Group license**.

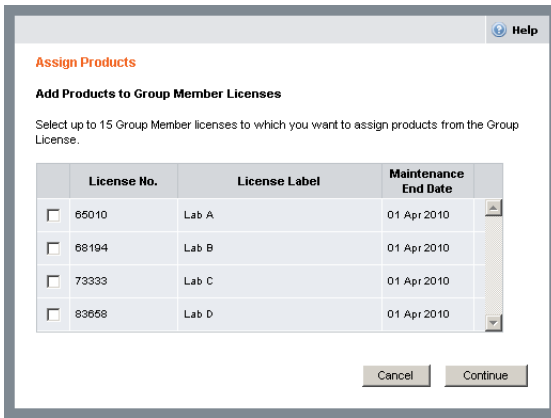

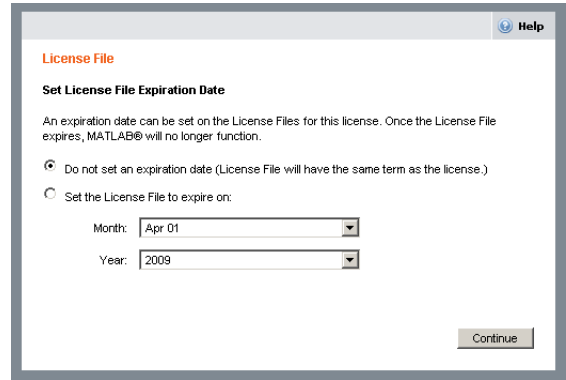

2 Click either the **Assign Products** or **Unassign Products** button.

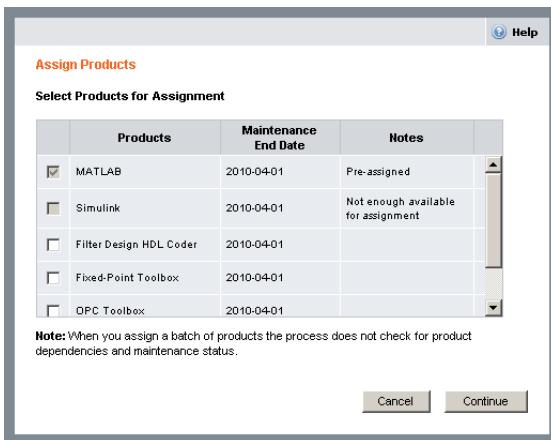
**Note:** The process for assigning and unassigning products on Group Member licenses is the same, with one additional step when assigning products, as noted below. These instructions show the Assign Products dialog.



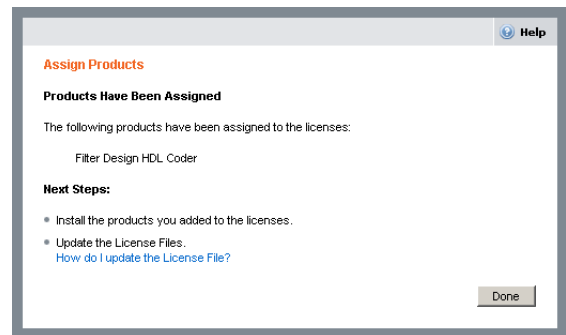
3 Check one or more Group Member licenses to which you want to assign or unassign products, and click Continue.



5 When assigning products, choose whether to set a License File expiration date that is different from the term of the license (do not exceed the term of the license), and click Continue.



4 Select or deselect products for this batch of Group Member licenses, and click Continue.



6 In the confirmation dialog, click Done.

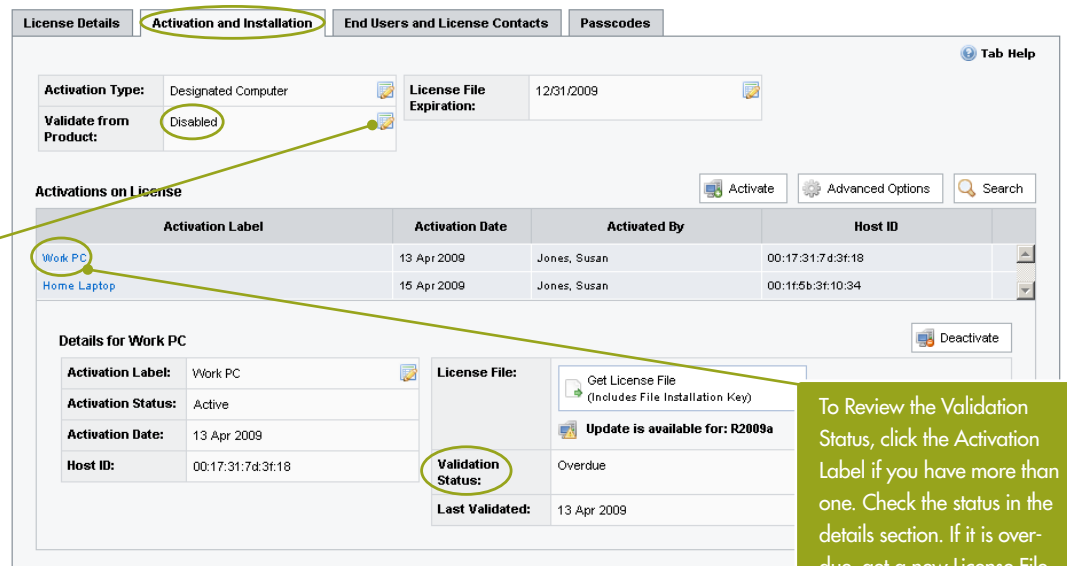
Next Steps:

- Install or uninstall products.
- Get a new License File on the Activation and Installation tab.

Note:

If you cannot unassign products on a license, go to the Activation and Installation tab to check that the Validate from Product setting is enabled and the Validation Status is current.

Review the Validate from Product setting. Click its edit icon to change it.



To Review the Validation Status, click the Activation Label if you have more than one. Check the status in the details section. If it is overdue, get a new License File.
