

GROUP LICENSES: ASSIGNING AND UNASSIGNING PRODUCTS ON A GROUP MEMBER LICENSE

A unique **Group Member license** is created for each copy of MATLAB on a Group license. Each Group Member license has its own product configuration. Administrators and asset managers configure licenses by assigning products from the Group license to Group Member licenses, and unassigning them for redesignation to another computer or user.

To get started...

1 Select the **Group license**.

2 Select the **Group member license**.

3 Click the **Assign/Unassign Products** button.

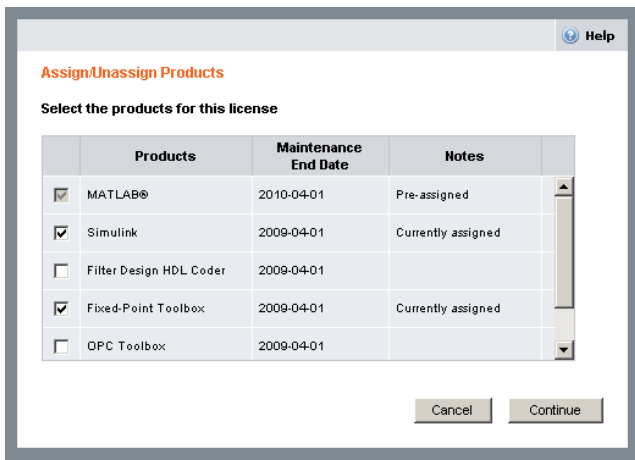

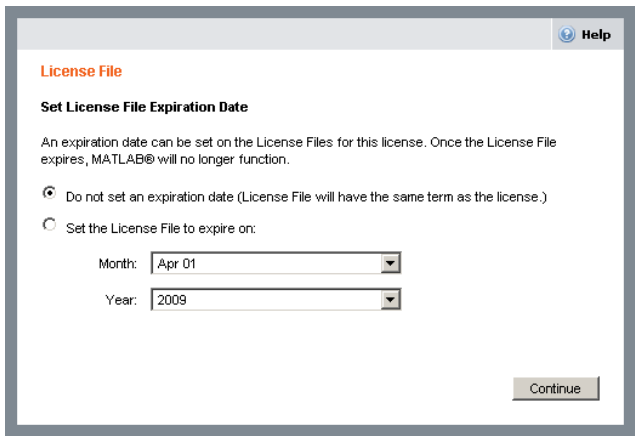

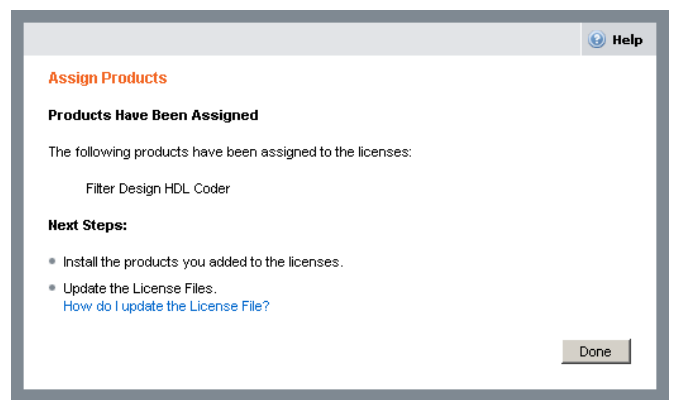

- 4 Select or deselect available products on the Group license for this Group Member license, and click Continue.
See note below if you cannot unassign products.



- 5 Choose whether to set a different License File expiration date (cannot exceed the term of the license), and click Continue.



- 6 Click Done.

The confirmation dialog lists the products on the license and any missing product dependencies that they require.

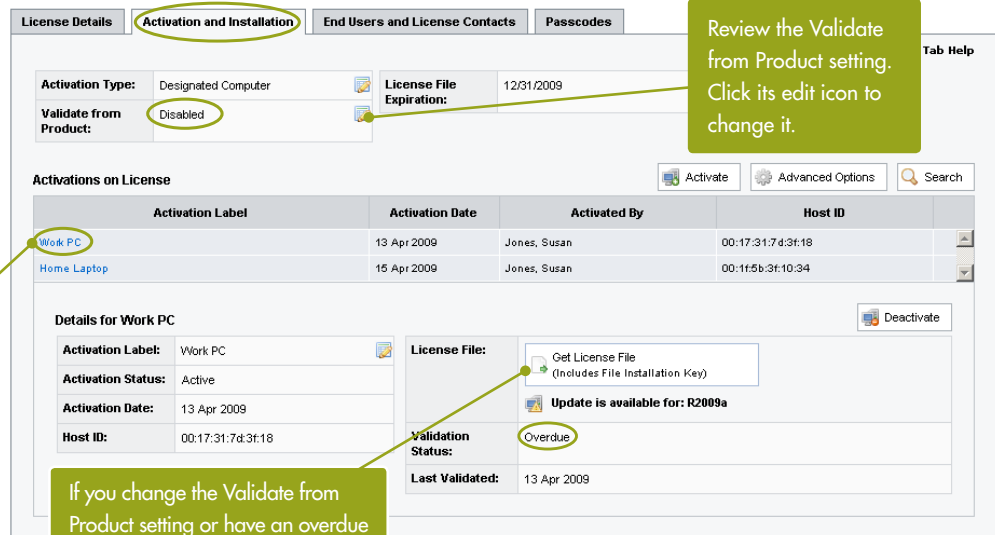
After assigning or unassigning products, you need to either install or uninstall the products and get an updated License File.

To get the file:

- Go to the Activation and Installation tab (see below).
- Click an activation label if you have more than one.
- Click the Get License File button.

Note:

If you cannot unassign products on a license, go to the Activation and Installation tab to check that the Validate from Product setting is enabled and the Validation Status is current.



To Review the Validation Status, click the Activation Label if you have more than one. Check the status in the details section. If it is overdue, get a new License File.

If you change the Validate from Product setting or have an overdue validation status, click the Get License File button to get a new file.

Review the Validate from Product setting. Click its edit icon to change it.
